Teams are set up with anywhere from 8 to 12 players depending on the signups for any given season. Each player gets a chance to bat, either by tee-ball pitch. The side is retired when the offense has batted through the roster. The Challenger players wear the same uniforms, shoulder patches and safety equipment as other Challenger League players.



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One of the benefits of having a Challenger Division is that it encourages the use of "buddies" for the Challenger players. The buddies assist the Challenger players on the field, but whenever possible, encourage the players to bat and make plays for themselves. However, the buddy is always nearby to help when needed.

Parents, teenagers and adults are strongly encouraged to become involved in this division of Challenger Senior League. Teenagers and adults may become buddies, after completing a Senior League volunteer application and passing a required national background check. Parents can become involved by being a buddy to their own child, becoming a coach, volunteer on the board, becoming a team mom, and/or other positions within the league.
